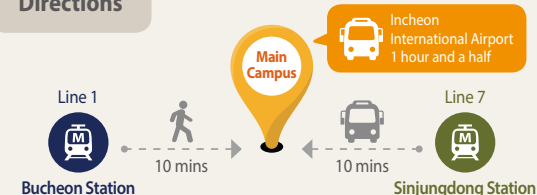

An independent activist, entrepreneur, and an educator who dedicated himself to life (夢堂) Han Hang-Gil sensed the right mind, and the right ideas. Sosa Institute of Technology, a predecessor of Bucheon University, was established based on the "Sense of Consciousness," which emphasizes correct wording. Han Hang-Gil was a leader of the March 1st independence movement of 1919. He led the street marches and was arrested and detained in Seodaemun Prison. While living in prison, there was no change in his determination to fight for independence. The issue "Mongdang (夢堂)" means that it represents a dream of a new world. In this way despite the tough realities faced by the Bucheon Global Language Center, inspired by the spirit of the dream-raising Mongdang (夢堂), it has opened the way for students to fly to the new world.

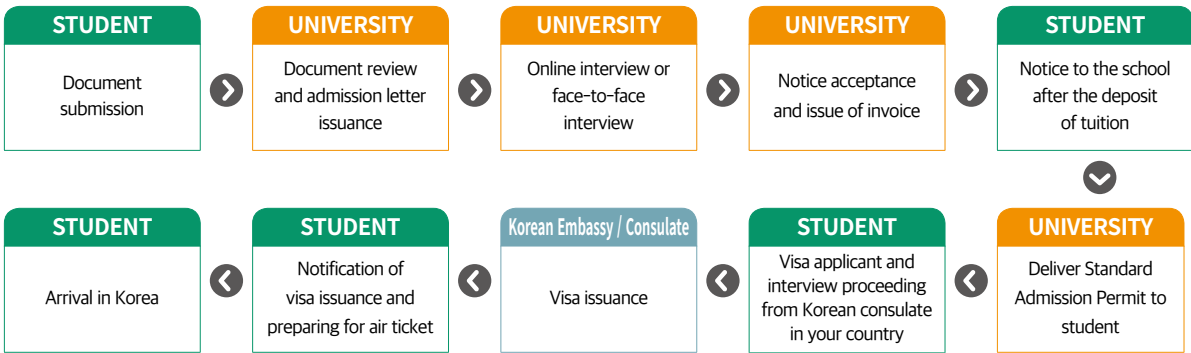
Applicant Requirements

A high school graduate or equivalent academic background

Application form

 - 2. Self-Introduction Letter (form2)**
 - 3. Study-Plan (form3)**
 - 4. Proof of Financial Status (Financial Sponsor Contract) (form4)**
 - 5. Personal Information Using Agreement (form5)**
 - 6. Final school (high school and above) graduation certificate original**
 - ※ Original documents are original documents (or notarized copies) issued by schools, banks, and government offices, and copies are not accepted.
 - ※ If you are unable to submit the original documents, please submit a copy of the document (the original document must be submitted for notarized embassy or Apostille documents)
 - ※ If the documents are in languages other than Korean, English, Chinese, and Japanese, both original and translated documents must be submitted after receiving translation notarization in one of the four languages above.
 - 7. Copy of final school transcript**
 - 8. (You or your parents) Documentary proof of USD 9,000 or more**
 - ※ At the time of submitting financial documents of parents (submission of parents' certificate, annual income certificate or copy of business registration of parents)
 - ① Balance deposit expiration date: Minimum 6 months from the date of receipt of documents (Deposit deferred)
 - ② Financial proof documents: Balance certificate (issue within 30 days)
 - 9. Certificate of family relationship between the individual and parents**
Family relationship certificate or Birth certificate
 - 10. TOPIK or KLAT Korean language transcript (only for holders)**
 - 11. Copy of passport (Alien registration card holders also submit a copy of alien registration card)**
 - 12. Photo (3.5cm*4.5cm)**
 - 13. Application Fee of 50.000KRW**
 - ※ All the notarized documents are only valid within 6 months after issued, and the financial proof document is only valid within a month(30 days) after issued.
 - ※ General training visa (D-4) : It can be extended up to 2 years in Korea.
 - ※ From March 2021, international students will be registered as members of the National Health Insurance in the same way as other foreigners.

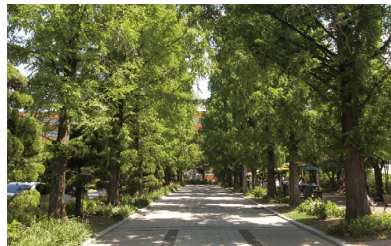
